GMR Group is a global infrastructure major with interests in **Airports, Energy, Highways and Urban Infrastructure** in addition to the **Agri-business** of sugar. GMR Energy Ltd. (GEL), the holding company of energy business of GMR Group, currently owns & operates Energy Assets totaling 810 MW. The Group is also currently developing around 4000 MW of Power projects. Several Hydro Projects of capacity totaling around 1600 MW in India / overseas are under advanced stages of development. Further, GMR had acquired 50% stake in **InterGen N.V.**, a 13000 MW power generation company with global footprint, largest –ever acquisition of a global energy utility by an Indian company. In July 2009, EMCO Energy Limited was taken over by GMR Energy Limited and has become a fully owned subsidiary of GMR Group.

EMCO Energy Limited (EEL) is in the process of developing a 2X300MW coal based thermal power project (“Project”) to be located at Warora, Chandrapur District, Maharashtra State and had earlier floated NIT / Invitation for Bids for BOP packages vide Tender Notification No. EEL/WARORA/002 dated 26th February 2009. The above said NIT for BOP packages was subsequently cancelled due to change in unit configuration from 1X300MW to 2X300MW.

The scope of work under the Project has been divided into a Boiler-Turbine-Generator (BTG) package and several other discrete BOP packages. Tender documents for the following BOP packages shall be released as per schedule mentioned below.

EEL invites sealed bids in two part bidding from eligible bidders for any one or more of the above packages as per the scope of work mentioned in the Tender Documents.

Qualifying Requirements:-

- The bidder, either directly by itself or through its subsidiary companies/parent company /joint venture partners, should have appropriate experience of turnkey execution of a similar package for a coal based power plant having plant size of 200 MW and above.
- In case of consortium, the consortium members should jointly satisfy the qualifying criteria stated above.

Issue of Tender Documents:-

Interested bidders may submit their requests for tender documents to the Owner's Engineer (contact details provided below) along with particulars of their experience / expertise, present work commitments, and other supporting documents (in case such documents are in language other than English, it should be submitted with duly translated versions in English) and non refundable payment of Rs 10,000/- per package in case of domestic bidders or USD 250/- per package in case of foreign bidders towards the cost of Tender Documents (subject to an upper limit of Rs 50,000/- / USD 1,250 for domestic/foreign bidders respectively in case a bidder buys tender documents for multiple packages) in the form of crossed demand draft drawn in favour of EMCO Energy Limited payable at Bangalore.
