रायपुर। रायखेड़ा गांव में स्थापित हो रहे जीएमआर वरलक्ष्मी फाउंडेशन (जीएमआर) और जीएमआर छत्तीसगढ़ एनर्जी के प्रयास से गांवों में स्वरोजगार के विभिन्न कार्यक्रम चलाए जा रहे हैं।
