Expenditure: 4.50 lakhs

Distribution of study material to 500 Telugu medium primary education students and NMMS and NTSE study material to 8th and 10th class students.

Provided Vidya Volunteer support to 2 Govt. Schools benefiting about 132 children. Expenditure: 2.15 lakhs

- Also conducted road safety programmes with companies along the road stretch, at Toll plazas and with Community people.

- Conducted National Road Safety Month programmes at Road Stretch and Toll Plazas.
- Organized National Safety week programme to working labours.
- Conducted Different Programmes involving Youth on Sanitation, Vigilance awareness, Yoga day and
 Women empowerment to create awareness on such aspects, around 1200 benefited
- Mobilized youth for Vocational training courses run at GMRVCEL-Hyderabad.
- Mobilized youth for Fastag Jobs in GHVEPL Road project.
- Free Drinking water supply was setup at Korlapahad, Panthangi, and ChilakalluToll plazas in summer.

Pochanpalli Expressway Region: Healthcare & COVID Relief activities:

Expenditure: 1.35 lakhs

Organized 4 medical camps and eye camps benefitting 694 drivers, labourers and road users from deprived communities in the villages adjacent to the Highway, organized Swachhata Pakhwada program and nutrition support to 50 HIV positive children. Support extended to around 70 elderly people residing at Old Age Home. and awareness campaign on COVID – 19 at Toll plaza. Around 6500 road users sensitized.

Provided cooked food to more than 300 migrant labourers every day during lockdown with the support of GPEL project staff at tool plazas.

Free drinking water facility was provided for migrant labourers passing through the toll plazas during the lockdown period.









Hyderabad Vijayawada Expressway: Healthcare activities

Expenditure: 2.89 lakhs

- Conducted Eye Screening Camps for 819 Lorry drivers and villagers and distributed 397 spectacles.
- Conducted two health camps benefitting 290 community people.
