### **Pochanpalli Expressway Region: Education activities**

#### **Expenditure: 5.50 lakhs**

Support extended to 3 Govt. schools providing 3 Vidya volunteers and academic support to enhance the FLN skills among the students and reaching out to 260 students in 3 villages, Specialized workbooks and other TLM material provided to 260 government school students in 3 villages. Distribution of study material to 500 Telugu medium primary education students and NMMS study material to 8<sup>th</sup> class students. Examination material distributed to 350 students. Celebrated special days in schools supported with snacks and gifts. Organized summer special classes at 2 govt schools to 80 students.


### **Pochanpalli Expressway Region: Community Development, Empowerment & Road Safety**

**Expenditure: 5.35 lakhs**

Road safety awareness programs conducted in association with Youth club members, Drivers Association, Educational Institutions, Transport Department, Police department and staff of the Roads project to create awareness on road safety aspects as relevant to different road users such as pedestrians, two wheelers, Autos, cars and heavy vehicles. During the year 2022-23, organized 135 Road safety awareness programs and sensitized about 29,560 road users.

The programmes include observation of National Road Safety Week Major Activities, Road safety audio & video song, 3 Days Road safety summer camp, Road safety Awareness Program & Drunken Drive with Police Department and RTO, 51<sup>st</sup> National Safety Day, Road Safety Program with Youth & Students, Safety awareness for working labours and Road Safety Awareness Program at Toll Plazas etc.

Organized special days i.e. World Environment Day, Azadi ka Amrit Mahostav, International Women's Day, International Yoga Day etc. reaching out 10456 members.



### **Hyderabad Vijayawada Expressway: Community Development, Empowerment & Road Safety**

### Expenditure: 5.19 lakhs

- Conducted 127 Road Safety awareness programs reaching out to about 21040 road users directly.
- Also conducted road safety programmes with College, school students, drivers, companies Police, RTO, along the road stretch, at Toll plazas and with Community people.
- Conducted National Road Safety Week programmes at Road Stretch and Toll Plazas. walkathons, shown live accident videos, Display flex boards distribution of Do's & Don'ts pamphlets
- Organized National Safety Day programmes and Road safety awareness to working labours.
- Organized Azadi ki Amruth Mahostav Programme felicitation and cash awards to the workers, historical tour to workers, plantation and display flex hoardings
- Organized Bike Rally's, Walkathons, Road safety with Rakhi (Special Events) Road safety Awareness Programs to Road users.
- Conducted Different Programmes involving Women's day, Environment day, Vigilance awareness, Yoga day and Women empowerment to create awareness on such aspects, around 1400 benefited.
- Set up empower stall at Orissa Dhaba for selling the Empower products in Highway NH-65.
- Mobilized youth for Vocational training courses run at GMRVCEL-Hyderabad.
- Free Drinking water supply was setup at Korlapahad, Panthangi, and Chilakallu plazas in summer.

## Pochanpalli Expressway Region: Healthcare

**Expenditure: 1.76 lakhs**

Organized 26 medical camps and eye camps benefitting 3000 Community people, drivers, labourers and road users from deprived communities in the villages adjacent to the Highway, organized Swachhata Pakhwada program and nutrition support and blankets distributed to 50 HIV positive children. Nutrition support and health awareness extended to around 150 women's. Supported for Covid Vaccination, 90000 of Napkins distributed to 3000 girl students and awareness on special days i.e. World Health Day, World Breast feeding week, World Tuberculosis day etc. at Project villages. Around 3720 community people sensitized.



## Hyderabad Vijayawada Expressway: Healthcare activities

**Expenditure: 1.78 lakhs**

- Conducted Eye Screening Camps for 740 Lorry drivers and villagers and distributed 383 spectacles.
- Conducted 6 health camps benefitting 917 community people.
- Organized 12 health awareness programs like TB, Sanitation, Tabaco day, Aids day, Disable day, etc. to Working Women's, Community people and Road users and support for snacks, gifts Multivitamins capsules, Pain gels, benefiting about 2500 people.
